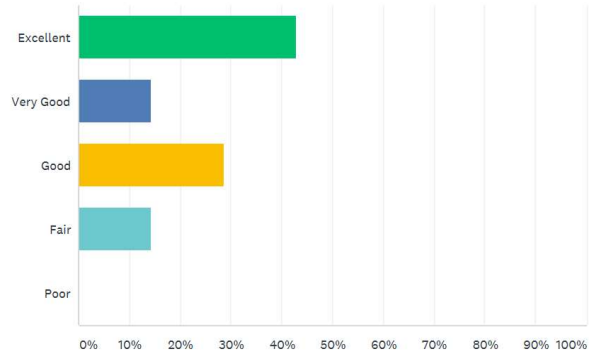

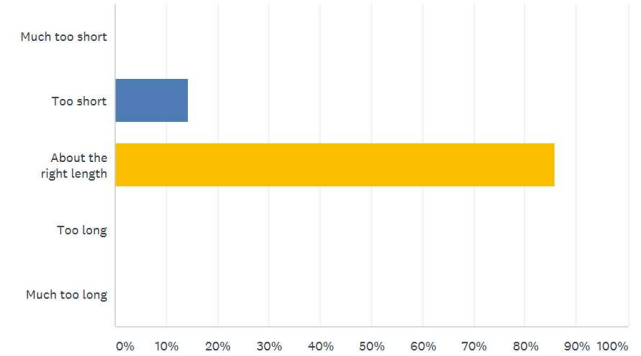
Overall, how would you rate the Change in Cities Webinar?

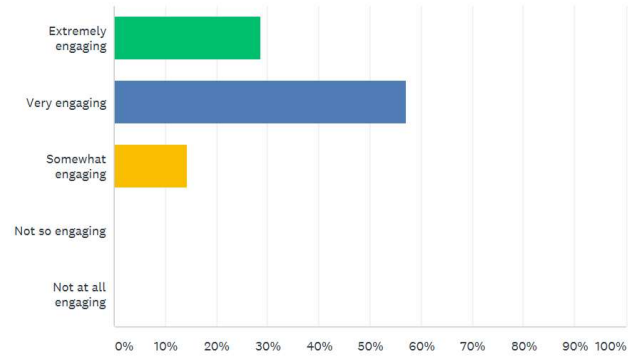
What do you think of the length of the Webinar?

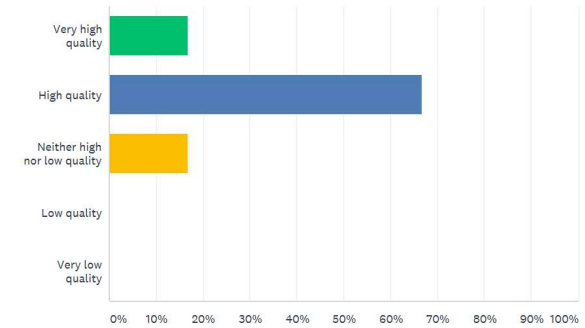

What are alumni doing to create change locally? Sharing stories, best practices, etc. anything that is trending that relates to coaching, complexity, and change.

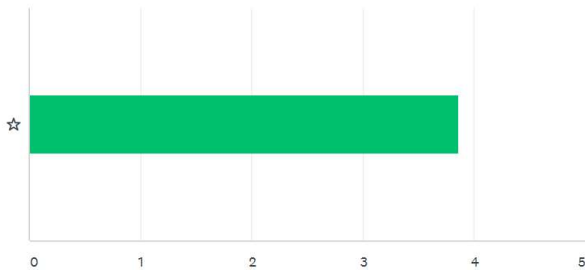

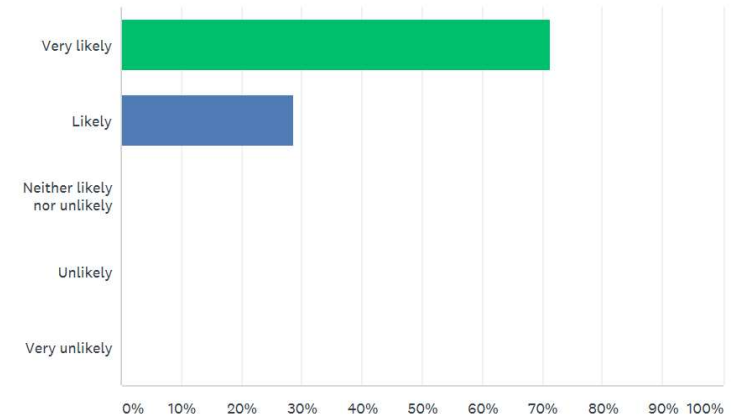
